**Lectures, Workshops, Stained Glass Festival Highlight
Historic Waco's Angels Exhibit**

WACO, TX October 17, 2013 -- Historic Waco Foundation today announced its line-up of programs that will accompany next month's stained glass exhibit "In Company With Angels."

The exhibit is making its Texas debut in Waco November 2, 2013 and will continue through January 26, 2014. The seven, eight-foot high, back-lit lancet windows were created by Louis Tiffany. They depict the angels addressed in chapters 2-3 of the book of Revelation.

"The events are designed to offer a deeper insight into the history behind these pieces of historical art," said Don Davis, Executive Director of Historic Waco Foundation.
